

## **Tiziano BRACCI** Bass Baritone

Tiziano Bracci is born in Milan, Italy, he studied singing at the Music Academy in Milan, he was a prize winner of many voice competitions, 2006 he won the second prize and the prize of the audience at the Vinas Competition in Barcelona.

He made his debut in opera as Timur in **Novara** and was a member of the ensemble of Deutsche Oper **Berlin** singing roles like Fra Melitone, Don Magnifico, Bartolo in "Nozze di Figaro", Kuno in "Freischütz" and Simone in "Gianni Schicchi".

Next contracts brought him to **Bergamo** with "Fille du régiment", to **Catania** with "La Serva Padrona" by Paisiello, to **Milan** with "Gianni Schicchi" with Mo. *Chailly*, to **Trieste** with "Il mondo della luna", to **Monte Carlo** with "Nozze di Figaro", to Théâtre du Châtelet in **Paris** as Bartolo in "Barbiere di Siviglia" and to **Feldkirch** with Mo. *Hengelbrock* as Leporello.

He sang Melitone in the new production of "Forza del destino" with Mo. *Mehta* at State Opera **Vienna**, Mustafa in "Italiana in Algeri" at Scottish Opera in **Glasgow**, Bartolo in "Barbiere di Siviglia" at Deutsche Oper **Berlin**, Capellio in "Capuletti e i Montecchi" at Konzerthaus **Vienna**, Plutone in "L'Orfeo" in **Paris**, "Tosca" in **Cologne**, Schaunard in **Abu Dhabi** and Melitone in **Essen**.
