Jorge Espino was born in Mexico City in 1992, he studied at the Conservatorio Nacional de Música in his hometown and continued his studies at the Academy of Vocal Arts in **Philadelphia**, where he performed Enrico, Masetto, Schaunard, Lescaut, Yeletzky and Manfredo in Montemezzi's "L'amore dei tre re".

2018 he won the 2° prize at the "Meistersinger" Competition in Graz, 2019 he took part in the Cardiff Singer of the World Competition, he was prize winner and finalist also in competitions in Jurmala, Finland, New York, Philadelphia, Glyndebourne and Mexico City.

He sang Belcore, Marcello and Sid in "Fanciulla del West" in **Mexico**, Count in "Nozze di Figaro" in **Cortina**, Prince Afron in "Coq d'Or" in **Santa Fe** and Papageno at Deutsche Oper am Rhein in **Düsseldorf**.
