Baurzhan Anderzhanov is born in Kasachstan he studied at the Kazakh National Academy of Music in Astana, and at Accademia d'Arte Lirica di Osimo, Italien.

He was heard as Lord Sidney in "Il Viaggio a Reims" at the Accademia Rossiniana del Rossini Opera Festivali in Pesaro and was invited back from Mo. Zedda to sing „Petite Messe Solennelle“ at Opera Teatre de St. Etienne.

He won the Singing Competition Anita Cerquetti, guest contracts brought him to Konzerthaus Vienna, Teatro dell'Opera di Roma, Opernhaus Graz, to Astana Opera and several times to Rossini Festival in Wildbad where he sung with Mo. Fogliani, Mo. Perez-Sierra and Mo. Gelmetti Lord Sidney in „Viaggio a Reims“, „Adelaide di Borgogna“, „L'inganno felice“ and “Bianca e Falliero”.

Recent and future engagements through the 2025/26 season include "Aureliano in Palmira", "Eduardo e Cristina" and "Moise et Pharaon" at Rossini Festival in Wildbad, Lord Sidney in "Viaggio a Reims" at Gran Teatro del Liceu in Barcelona, Don Basilio at Teatro delle Muse in Ancona, Italy, „Giovanna d'Arco“ and „Pirata“ at Klangvokal Musikfestival in Dortmund, „Nozze di Figaro“ in Ferrara, “Aida” in Kiel, „Metamorfosi di Pasquale“ in Jesi, Collin in Bratislava, „Ballo“, „Lucia“ “Aida” and „Maid of Orleans“ in Düsseldorf, „Nabucco“ in Karlsruhe, Collin in Bratislava and Lucerne and „Tabarro“ / “Gianni Schicchi“ in Saarbrücken.
