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## Giordano LUCÀ Tenor

Giordano Lucá was born in Rome, he was discovered by Katia Riccarelli, who encouraged him to study to be an opera singer, he began his studies at the Music Institute of Milan and attended master classes given by Enzo Dara, Monserrat Caballè and Marcelo Alvarez.

Giordano is a prize winner of several international competitions, including second prize at Operalia and the public prize at BBC Cardiff Singer of the World. First contracts brought him to Teatro Verdi in <u>Padua</u> as "Rigoletto" Duke, a role he sang later on also in <u>Rovigo</u> and at Teatro Regio in <u>Parma</u>.

He made his debut as Rodolfo in "Boheme" at Teatro Giocosa in <u>Savona</u> and sang "Boheme" then also in <u>Bergamo</u> and <u>Ravenna</u> as well as in Greece in <u>Corfu</u>.

He was heard as "Rigoletto" Duke in <u>Bahrain</u> and at Teatro Municipale in <u>Piacenza</u>, as Alfredo in "Traviata" with Mo. Kuhn in <u>Erl</u>, as Cassio at Teatro Alighieri in <u>Ravenna</u>, where he returned as Macduff. He sang "Boheme" at Teatro Carlo Felice in <u>Genoa</u>, in <u>Madrid</u>, in <u>San Sebastian</u> and in <u>Tallinn</u>, where he was invited back for "Rigoletto" Duke, furthermore he sang concerts in <u>Milan</u> and <u>Frankfurt</u>.

He sang Tebaldo in "Capuleti ed i Montecchi" in <u>Klagenfurt</u>, "Boheme" in <u>Valencia</u>, "Traviata" and "Rigoletto" in <u>Tallinn</u>, "Boheme" in <u>Santander</u>, Macduff at Festival <u>Savonlinna</u> and Tebaldo in <u>Padua</u>.

Recent and future engagements through the 2025/26 season include Rodolfo in "Boheme" in Naples, Rovigo, Portland and in India, Leicester in "Maria Stuarda" at Teatro dell 'Opera in Rome, "Traviata" Alfredo with Mo. Kuhn in Erl, in Tallinn and Klagenfurt, Edgardo in "Lucia" in Padua and Budapest, "Verdi Requiem" in Hilversum, "Rigoletto" in Ravenna, Ismaele in Amsterdam, Duke in "Rigoletto" with Mo. Muti in Tokyo, Nemorino in Padua, Rodolfo in Rome, Saragozza and Vilnius a Boheme concert in Lübeck and "Traviata" in Kassel.

Concert engagements brought him to several cities in Italy but also abroad to <u>Beijing</u>, <u>Glasgow</u>, <u>Bremen</u>, <u>Astana</u>, <u>Amsterdam</u>, <u>Copenhagen</u>, <u>London</u> and <u>Frankfurt</u>.
