Ariana Lucas is born in California was a recipient of the James H. Schwabacher Memorial Scholarship, the Asya Pleschach Scholarship, the Dorothy Augusta Memorial Music Scholarship and the first prize winner of the Bertha Stever/Pascal Mounk Scholarship Competition. She received her master's degree in Voice from San Francisco Conservatory of Music and moved to Germany to begin her study of the German repertoire.

2018 he received a prize in "Wagner Stimmen" Competition in <u>Karlsruhe</u> and 2019/20 she is a prize winner at the Competition "Stignani" in <u>Imola.</u>

She was a member of the <u>Luxembourg</u> Opera Studio and began her Wagner studies at Voice Studio <u>Munich</u> with the renowned German mezzo Camilla Ueberschaer. She made her German debut as Erda in David Hermann's new production of "Rheingold" at Badisches Staatstheater <u>Karlsruhe</u>. She returned to <u>Karlsruhe</u> singing Erda as well as Schwertleite in "Walküre" and the new production of "Adriana Lecouvreur".

She was member of the ensemble in <u>Karlsruhe</u> where she sang roles like 3° Dame in "Zauberflöte", Gertrude in "Romeo et Juliette", Ute in "Die Lustigen Nibelungen", Amastre in "Serse" at Händelfestpiele in <u>Karlsruhe</u>. Moreover, she is heard as Flosshilde in "Götterdämmerung" in <u>Wuppertal</u>, with "Matthäuspassion" in <u>Heidelberg</u>, as Erda in "Rheingold" in **Bielefeld** and as Brigitta in "Tote Stadt" in **Wuppertal**.
