2024 she was a prize winner at the Giuditta Pasta Competition in Milan and 2025 at the “Clip” Competition in Portofino.

Until 2025/26 she is member of the Opera Studio in Stuttgart, where she sings Gianetta, 1<sup>st</sup> Dame in “Zauberflöte”, Wellgunde, Karolka in “Jenufa”, Sand- and Taumännchen and Blume in “Parsifal”.

Recent and future engagements through the 2025/26 season include “Orphée aux enfers” at Schloss Henfenfeld near Nuremberg, Micaela and Helena in “Midsummer Night’s Dream” in Tel Aviv, Stabat Mater by Rossini in Bad Säckingen, 5<sup>th</sup> Magd in Cologne, “Suor Angelica” at Opera Bastille in Paris, Mimi in Coburg, 1<sup>st</sup> Dame in “Zauberflöte” in Düsseldorf and Fiordiligi in Klagenfurt.
