Mezzosoprano Alžběta Vomáčková graduated from Prague Conservatory as a student of Brigita Šulcová in 2013. Currently she studies at Music and Dance Faculty of the Academy of Performing Arts in Prague as a student of Roman Janál.

She was prize winner of numerous competitions, so she won the 2nd prize at the International Singing Competition Ferruccio Tagliavini, <u>Deutschlandsberg/Graz</u> in Austria, the 3rd prize at Imrich Godin International Singing Competition Iuventus canti, Vráble in <u>Slovakia</u>, the 2nd and the 3rd prize (Junior) at Antonín Dvořák's International Singing Competition in Karlovy Vary in <u>Czech Republic</u>.

She made her guest appearance in the role of Ježibaba in "Rusalka" at the North Bohemian Opera and Ballet Theatre <u>Ustí nad Labem</u>. She regularly appears at the F. X. Šalda Theater in <u>Liberec</u>, J. K. Tyl Theatre in <u>Pilsen</u>, South Bohemian Theatre in <u>České Budějovice</u>, Revolving Open-Air Theatre Český <u>Krumlov</u>, National Moravian-Silesian Theatre in <u>Ostrava</u> and the National Theater in <u>Prague</u>, where she made her debut in the role of Fjodor in "Boris Godunov".

She performed Amneris, Preziosilla, Maddalena, Nicklausse, Siebel, Annio, Tigrana in "Edgar", 3rd Dame in "Zauberflöte", Ježibaba, Kitchen boy and 3rd Wood Sprite in "Rusalka" and Hadač in "Julietta" in <u>Czech Republic</u>.

Recent and future engagements through the 2025/26 season include include the new productions of "Edgar" as Tigrana and of "Rusalka" as Foreign Princess and Jezibaba in <u>St. Gallen</u>, Cherubino, Pipetto in "Le convenienze ed inconvenienze teatrali" and 3rd Wood Sprite and Kuchtik in <u>Prague</u>, "Juliette", Fenena and Polina in "Pique Dame" in <u>Ostrava</u>, Suzuki in <u>Reichenberg</u>, Olga in "Eugen Onegin" in <u>Budweis</u>, and "Cunning little vixen" at Theater an der Wien in <u>Vienna</u> and Amneris, Suzuki, Fenena in <u>Liberec</u>.
